The Mission of Faery Tails Corgi Rescue of St. Louis Inc.: We are devoted to providing care and placement into quality adoptive homes for displaced, neglected, and/or abused Pembroke & Cardigan Welsh Corgis, as well as other unfortunate dogs. We are committed to enhancing the human-dog relationship through education.

We are an all volunteer, state licensed, 501 (C) (3) tax-exempt nonprofit organization.

Your answers on this application will help us find the best possible match between you and the dogs in our care. The more we know, the better we are able to make each adoption a success. All information is confidential.

Applications are processed in the order they are received. Please remember we are a volunteer organization - we might not be able to move as fast as we would like. In all cases, the final placement decision is based on suitability of each dog for a particular home. Placement will not be made until the application has been approved, and the home visit completed.

We reserve the right to refuse an applicant.

Our contract stipulates that if, for any reason, you can't keep your adopted friend, s/he must come back to our group! Because of this, we tend to be very thorough and particular in our adoptions. Typically we do not place our dogs in homes with very young children - although we will consider families with children who are considerate of animals.

We typically place our dogs in the St. Louis and surrounding areas. We will consider placement outside of this area, unless a note appears on the particular dog's bio. We do not ship dogs - you will have to come to St. Louis to pick up your new dog. If you have questions please contact us.

Long distance calls may be returned collect. You will be added to our internal mailing list to keep you advised on FTCT events and information (for program use only).

Please advise your references that you listed their name so they can expect a call. We also require a veterinary reference – it is important that you notify your vet clinic so they can release information to our organization.
